

The Yard Waste Collection Program begins in Spring and lasts until December.

The Yard Waste Collection Program has three (3) specific time periods:

Spring Collection (weekly pickup)

March 28th to April 29th

Toter Only Collection (bi-weekly pickup by zone)

May 2nd to September 30th

Fall Collection (weekly pickup)

October 3rd to December 9th

During the **Toter Only Collection** period yard waste is collected the same day as your regular household pickup and each day is divided into 2 zones, A and B, which are collected on alternate weeks. Yard Waste should be set out following the same guidelines as household waste. Maps showing your zone are available at the Robert E. Jones Municipal Building, Public Works Facility, or on our website at www.danvillepublicworks.org

From May 2nd until September 30th all yard waste will only be picked up in city approved toters with a current 2016 yard waste sticker attached. Pickup will be every other week by zone.

Bags may only be used during the Spring and Fall Collection periods which will be approximately 4 weeks in the Spring and 6 weeks in the Fall (weather permitting).

Yard waste stickers are \$40 each and are sold at the locations listed below. Stickers are good for one calendar year. Toters may also be purchased at either location for \$65 and will be delivered to your residence.

- **Independence Day** July 4
- **Labor Day** September 5
- **Veterans Day** November 11
- **Thanksgiving Day** November 24

ADDITIONAL COLLECTION INFORMATION

- **Bare**, live trees (no stands or decorations) will be collected after the 1st of January. Please watch your local media for the dates. Flocked trees may be scheduled to be picked up with excess garbage.
- Yard Waste collection will stop after the January collection and continue again in the Spring.

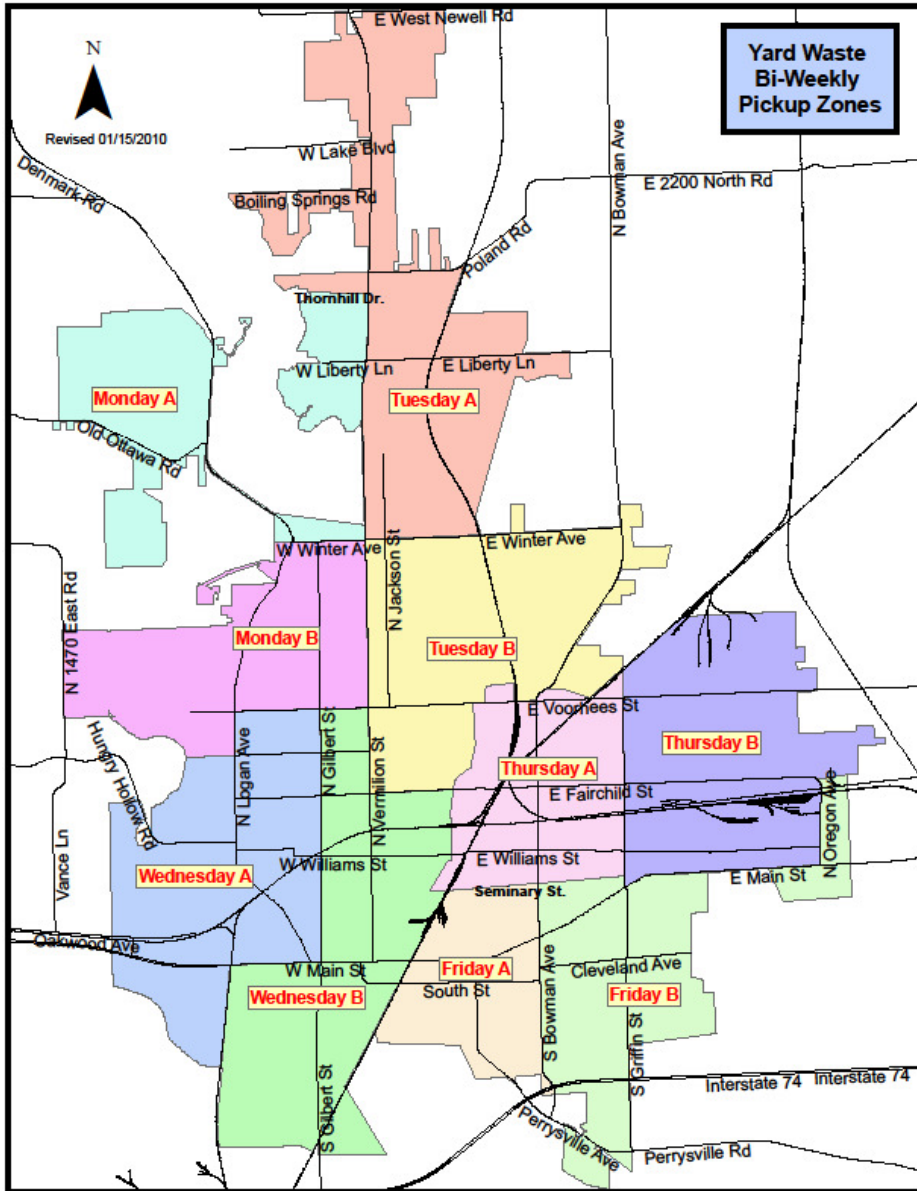

Yard Waste Collection Information



During the Toter Only Collection period from May 2nd to September 30th yard waste will be collected as follows:

ZONE A will be picked up beginning the week of May 2nd and **ZONE B** the week of May 9th. **ZONE A** and **B** will then alternate weeks until the end of the Toter Only Collection period on September 30th.

All yard waste must be contained in one of the following ways:

1. City approved toter (up to 96 gallon capacity), with current yard waste sticker and no more than 200lbs. of yard waste material.
2. During the Spring and Fall Collection periods residents may use any approved paper yard waste bag. Yard waste bags are available at various retail outlets, pricing set by stores. **NO** tape or adhesive permitted on Yard Waste bags.

Please note: bags are not allowed between May 2nd and September 30th, but toters are allowed during all three collection periods.

Yard waste contained in plastic bags or boxes **WILL NOT be collected.**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE CONSIDERED YARD WASTE:

Grass, Leaves, Shrubbery Trimmings, Garden Waste (no food products), Brush. **All items, including brush, must be placed in the toter during the Toter Collection period between May 2nd and September 30th.**

During the Spring and Fall Cleanup periods brush should be placed no closer than two (2) feet from the Toter, bundled, tied with cotton twine or string, and no larger than 3 inches in diameter or more than 4 feet long.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED WITH YARD WASTE:

Stumps, Landscaping Timbers, Railroad Ties, Dirt, Gravel, Rock, Straw, Hay Bales, Pumpkins and Christmas Trees that are contaminated with flocking, tinsel, etc.

(Straw, Hay, Pumpkins, and Contaminated Christmas Trees may be placed with household waste).

The City sells (for pick up or delivery) the following products processed at our Yard Waste Recycling facility (prices subject to change).

Compost - \$25 per yard - (up to 5 yards delivered) Mulch - \$25 per yard - (up to 5 yards delivered) Mixed Firewood - \$40 per rick (**Pick up only**)

The City charges \$30.00 for delivery and is limited to within a 5 mile radius of the City. The City Yard Waste Facility is located one mile east of North Bowman Ave. and E. Liberty Ln., at the intersection of County Rd. 2100N and 1900E.

Yard Waste Site Hours: Monday and Friday, 7:30AM-Noon, 1:00PM-3:00PM Wednesday, 7:30AM-Noon

Customers with a current 2016 Yard Waste Sticker may drop off yard waste at the Yard Waste Facility at no additional charge.

Those customers must call 431-2288 to arrange a drop off time.
